### **Simple Present**

**Meaning** 1: Habitual, regular action in the present.

Time expressions: usually; every day; often; sometimes; rarely; never.

**Examples:** I usually work till seven o'clock. I often talk to him on the phone. He visits them sometimes.

Meaning 2: Stating a fact, general truth, state or condition.

**Examples**: He lives in Moscow and works at a bank. He plays the piano quite well. Her house is very small. The sun rises in the east.

#### Simple past

Meaning: The action happened (started and ended) in the past.

Time expressions: yesterday; last week; last year; in 1995; in 2009; two hours ago; four years ago.

**Examples:** I saw him an hour ago. He came back last Friday. She went to the theater yesterday. They visited London in 2009.

**Note:** Use the simple past for completed past actions, including past actions that lasted for some time or happened one after another.

## **Simple future**

**Meaning:** The action will happen in the future.

Time expressions: tomorrow; in a few days; next week; in 2025; in the future.

**Examples:** I think he will return next week. I will probably see him in a few days. We'll be home after eight.
